This is marked as a question for people 15 or aged 15 or over has the person being told they were born with the variation of sex characteristics. Some brackets, sometimes called intersex or differences of sex. Develop, this question refers to an eight productive development, reproductive development, sorry, genetics or hormones. That do not fit the medical norms for female or male bodies. These specific characteristics may be noticed at Birth or developing puberty in Brackets options. Yes, no don't know. Prefer not to answer now. My comments. I

As a diversity educator in part of my life. I think that those are pretty good now. So long, as you've really got another term and give the open field and prefer not to answer your.
